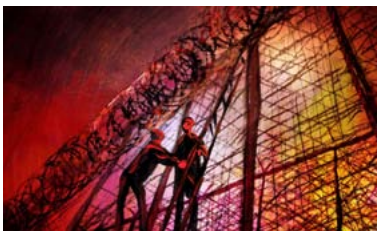

GREEN JAIL

Yin-Yu Huang / documentary / 90 minutes / France+Taiwan+Japan / in progress
Grandma Hashima is the last person alive to tell the stories of "Green Jail", the most notorious coal mine in imperial Japanese history, where the miners from Japanese colonies were imprisoned before World War II. This film portrays the last years of her life, and the final questions to the mystery of her life.



NOODLE DREAM
